Slipping 'n' Sliding

At the time of writing, the Parish is bathed in beautiful summer sunshine, so you could be forgiven for banishing the extreme winter weather experienced in November and December 2010 to the back of your mind, however please spare this a thought. The terrible icy conditions highlighted a major problem within Brizlincote: the lack of facilities to grit roads and footpaths in some parts. With much of the Parish built on an incline the snow and ice hit us harder

than most, with many areas being dangerous to use or at worst rendered virtually impassable.

A recent survey by Staffordshire County Council showed the need for over 600 grit bins countywide, and although we have been fortunate to be granted funds for a number of problem areas, this only goes part way to make the Parish a safe place to travel when the winter hits hard.

The good news is that the Parish Council has earmarked funds to pay for a number of grit bins, but we need your



help to highlight the areas of greatest need. Each case will be judged on its own merit, with the number of houses served, volume of road and foot traffic, steepness of incline, vicinity of nearest bin and availability of a suitable location all being taken into consideration.
