The Chair reported a concern from a resident regarding the encroachment of one property onto the road at Brizlincote Lane – Councillor Wileman agreed to look into this matter. The issues of standing water on the High Street were also discussed - in particular with reference to the area by the post box and outside Primark. There was also further conversation regarding Bargates.

Councillor Lomas asked about the progress of the Violet Way parking and Councillor Wileman explained that a detailed plan is awaited before the project can go forward for inclusion into the integrated plan.
